The Board of County Road Commissioners of Mason ^{County} met at the Court House in Lodiington on Monday April 16th 1894 at 2 o'clock P.M.

The meeting was called to order by the Clerk of said Board

By a vote of a majority of the members of the Board - Cyrus A. Jobey was elected Chairman for the ensuing year or during the pleasure of the Board.

The members present and voting. are Cyrus A. Jobey, elected for one year; Archy B. Knutler elected for two years; and G. D. Cowan elected for three years -

Moved by Mr. Knutler that this Board raise two dollars on each one thousand dollars of the assessed valuation of the County for the year 1893 for County Road Purposes - Carried

Moved by Mr. Cowan that it is the determination of this Board that the heretofore known as the Oceana and Manistee State Road shall hereafter be a County Road except that portion of said road that lies within the incorporated village of Scottville, and shall be known as the Oceana and Manistee County Road - ✓

Carried by ayes & Nays - all voting aye -

Moved by Mr. Knutler that it is the determination of this Board that the road heretofore known as the Mason County State Road shall be a County Road, except those portions of said road lying within Lodiington City limits, and within the limits of the incorporated Village of Scottville, and shall be known as the Mason East and West County Road

Carried by ayes & Nays, all voting aye

On motion of Mr. Cowan the Board adjourned till Saturday May 5th

Resolved that the following named roads, heretofore organized by the Board of Supervisors as State Roads, shall be and they are hereby determined by this Board to be County Roads under the provisions of the County Road Law and shall be known by names as follows -

The Allegan, Muskegon and Traverse Bay County Road

The Branch and Pere Marquette County Road

The Sherman and Sheridan County Road

The Amber and Victory County Road

The Buster and Free Soil County Road

The resolution was adopted by ayes 3 nays 0 all voting aye -

Resolved that the road located and described as follows be adopted by this Board as the Fountain County Road - no. - Commencing at the Custer and Freesail Road, running East between sections 10 and 15 and 14 and 9 to the village of Fountain

The Resolution was adopted by Ayes and Nays as follows:

Ayes Tobey, Cowan - 2 - Nays Hunter - 1
