and that the contract be let on Feb. 12th next, and that Bridge Builders
be notified that such contract will be let.

Resolved that this Board determine, authority having been given by the Board of Supervisors, that the amount of tax raised for the County Road Fund for the year 1896 shall be two dollars on each one thousand dollars of the assessed valuation of 1895, amounting to \$6368 55
