INSTALLATION OF SIGNS WITHIN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY

- 1. The Mason County Road Commission, (MCRC) has adopted the following policy pertaining to the installation of signs within the right-of-way.
- 2. The MCRC no longer allows the installation of decorative signage within the right of way on roadways which are under the direct jurisdiction and authority of the Board of County Road Commissioners. Decorative lighting and signage which are placed within the right of way of County primary and local roads may be removed and disposed of by the MCRC, without notice.
- 3. All decorative signage that has been installed without approval of the MCRC will be subject to removal and disposal.
- 4. Political signs, which are placed within rights-of-way on County roads under the direct jurisdiction and control of the MCRC or on State trunklines under the direct jurisdiction and control of the Michigan Department of Transportation are prohibited and shall be removed by the MCRC without notice. The removed signs shall be retained by the MCRC for a period of seven days. If said signs are not called for or picked up by the sign owner or his/her designee, they shall be disposed of by the MCRC.
