Quantity and Specifications

Seasonal Requirements for one (1) year commencing April 1, 2024 shall be received for twelve (12) month supply of Diesel fuel. Diesel fuel shall meet the general industry standards necessary to achieve an Ultra Low Sulfur #2 Diesel Specification. Fuel specifications are to be attached to the Bid. The estimated usage is 150,000 gallons per year with available underground storage of 20,000 gallons.

The successful vendor shall deliver the fuel upon order or demand at the Mason County Road Commission Garage located at 510 East Main Street, Scottville, MI 49454.

The estimated usage is 25,000 gallons per year with available underground storage of 4,000 gallons.
