## **SNOW AND ICE CONTROL**

- 1. The Mason County Road Commission, (MCRC) has adopted the following policy pertaining to snow and ice removal and coordination with governmental agencies.
- 2. The MCRC shall perform snow and ice control on a priority basis with State, Primary and Local roads being the order of priority.
- 3. During regular business hours, foreman and/or maintenance patrols will verify the need for snow and ice control activities and assign vehicle and personnel accordingly.
- 4. After regular business hours, if immediate road maintenance for snow and ice control is determined warranted by the MCRC Maintenance Superintendent, Assistant Maintenance Superintendent, Foremen, and/or Night Patrol crew, will be instructed to proceed with callouts of all on-call service center personnel for snow and ice control activities.
- 5. For media inquiries pertaining to snow and ice control activities, the following people shall be contacted:
  - 5.1 Maintenance Superintendent
  - 5.2 Foreman
  - 5.3 Manager/Director
- 6. Unless authorized by one of the above supervisors, all MCRC personnel should refrain from contact with representatives of the media.
